


What are the two words missing from the above portico?



Symmetry - equal position, size and shape of parts, arranged on either side of an imaginary line or axis

I Keystone - centre stone at the top of an arch

Portico -a roof supported by columns or piers, usually attached to a building as a porch.


Pediment- a triangular area on the face of a building below the roof, above a window or entrance

Cornice - decorative moulding that projects up from the top of a building

Lintel - structure over a door or window opening that supports the weight of the wall above it

Sill - structure or ledge under a window

Coat of Arms - a special design in the form of a shield used as a symbol of identity




Adaptive Reuse of Buildings ARCHITECTURE WALK

- START at the Curator's House Restaurant in Rolleston Ave.
- 2. Walk north to the Former Christchurch Girls'High School at the Arts Centre and turn into Hereford St.
- 3. Walk along Hereford St to Old Chemistry and Biology & Observatory of Canterbury College.
- 4. To West Avon Apartments and Dux De Lux.
- **5.** Walk towards **Registry Building** and **The Villas** in Montreal St.
- **6.** Double back to Hereford St to **CHCH City Council.**
- 7. Head east along Oxford Terrace, stop and see Equitable House and Public Trust Building.
- **8. Former Municipal Chambers** on the corner of Worcester St.
- **9.** Along Worcester St. to Cathedral Square and the **Former Chief Post Office.**
- 9.5 View to Law Courts and Isaac House
- **10.** View **The Press Building** facade on Gloucester St and New Regent St.
- 11. Go through Cathedral Junction to Heritage Hotel
- **12.** Continue on Worcester St. to the **State Insurance Building.**
- 13. Along to the Trinity Congregational
- **14.** Turn south into Manchester St to **Shand's Emporium** and view to the **IRD** building.
- **15.** Along High St to **Criterion House** and the **Canterbury Terminating Building Society** building.
- **15.5** Walk south east along High St to Victoria Black, MAINZ, Cotter's and Smash Palace
- **16. McKenzie and Willis** and **Alice's** on High St.
- **17.** Ending at the **Odeon** on Tuam St.
